Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 03.07.2024 and subsequent correspondence with the School/ Inspection in this regard, I Education Officer convey and grant for provisional RTE recognition to the **Dhanvallabh English High School, NCWA Education Complex, P.K.Road, Mulund (W), Mumbai – 400 080** for (CBSC Curriculum) **Class 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>** for a period of three years w.e.f. **dt 01.06.2023 to 31.05.2026**

The above sanction is subject fulfillment of following conditions:-

14. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognized or affiliate beyond class VIII.
15. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to free Compulsory Education Rules,2011 (Annexure II)
16. The School shall admit in Class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide to them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of Pre-Primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
17. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account.

18. The Society/ School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
19. The School shall not deny admission
- To any child for lack of age proof.
  - On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
20. The School shall ensure:
- (ix) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in the school.
  - (x) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
  - (xi) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education .
  - (xii) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.
  - (xiii) Students with disabilities/special needs are included as per provision of the Act.
  - (xiv) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23 (1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of the Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.
  - (xv) The teacher performs his or her duties specified under section 24 (1) of the Act and
  - (xvi) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.
21. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
22. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
23. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:
- Area of School Campus :- 2850 Sq.m
  - Total built up area :- 808.20 Sq.m
  - Area of Play ground :- 557.62 Sq.m
  - No. of class rooms :- 16
  - Rooms for Headmaster-cum-Storeroom :- Yes
  - Separate toilet for boys and girls with adequate Water facility for using and keeping toilets in clean & hygienic conditions :- Yes
  - Drinking water facility :- Yes
  - Kitchen for cooking Mid Day Meal :- N. A.
  - Availability of Teaching Learning Material/ Play Sport Equipments/ Library Barrier free Access to teaching – learning materials , Play and Sports equipments, reading materials :- Yes
24. No unrecognized classes or divisions shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
25. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes education and skill development.

26. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) , or the Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950.
14. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person or for any other profit.
15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Dy.EO (Aided ) MCGM Office every year. If the fund surplus Reports, then the shool Management should not increase the annual fees without getting prior permission of the competent authority.
16. The recognition code Number allotted to your school is **27230400404** This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.
17. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the of the Government or Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school;
18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
19. Other conditions as per Annexure 'III' enclosed.
20. "The No Objection Certificate (NOC) submitted by the school management is valid upto ..... It is mandatory to obtain a fresh (valid) No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the school management. Currently, the school management remains responsible for the safety of the students in the school as per the undertaking submitted by the school management. Also, if a complaint is received from the Government or the Municipal Corporation regarding the validity of the site/suitability/validity of the construction/complaint, the school management will be required to take action as per the rules. Based on these conditions, the school is being given an **RTE Namuna-2 certificate**. Also the said **RTE Namuna -2 Certificate** of validity of school premises or suitability of construction does not validate."
