Ensuring a Safe, Secure, and Nurturing Environment for Every Child

At Dhanavallabh School, the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors is our highest priority. We are committed to maintaining a safe, secure, and inclusive environment through proactive measures, regular training, and strict adherence to CBSE and government safety guidelines.

1. Campus Safety & Security

- Entry/Exit gates are monitored by trained security guards during school hours.
- Visitor entry is strictly regulated through a visitor pass system with ID verification.
- CCTV surveillance is installed in all strategic locations including corridors, gates, playgrounds, and common areas.
- Fire extinguishers and emergency exits are installed and checked regularly.

2. Staff & Visitor Guidelines

- All teaching and non-teaching staff undergo police verification.
- Staff are trained regularly in child safety, first aid, and emergency response.
- Visitors are not allowed in academic blocks without prior permission and are accompanied by staff.

***** 3. Safe Transport Guidelines

- All school transport vehicles comply with RTO safety regulations.
- GPS tracking in school buses.
- Lady attendants and trained drivers are appointed for each bus.
- Students are picked up and dropped off only at pre-designated points.

4. Student Protection Policy

- A dedicated Child Protection Committee oversees student well-being and grievance redressal.
- Anti-bullying policies are enforced through regular awareness sessions.
- Students are encouraged to speak up through a structured complaint mechanism.
- Safe Touch-Unsafe Touch awareness is conducted for primary students.

🚶 5. Safe Pickup and Drop-off Instructions

- Only parents/authorized guardians with ID proof are allowed to pick up students.
- No student is permitted to leave the school premises during school hours without a gate pass signed by the principal/class teacher.
- Special attention is given to dispersal time with staff deployment at all key points.

6. Health & Emergency Preparedness

- Regular health check-ups are conducted for all students.
- Emergency evacuation drills (fire, earthquake, etc.) are held every term.
- Tie-ups with nearby hospitals are in place for emergency referrals.

7. Complaint Redressal & Nodal Officer Contact

- Grievance Redressal Cell handles all parent and student complaints confidentially.

- An online form for anonymous reporting is available on the school portal.

8. Cyber Safety & Digital Conduct

- Digital literacy sessions are held for students on safe and responsible use of the internet.
- Parental control tools and digital safety agreements are encouraged for students using online platforms.
- Teachers monitor online classroom behavior during virtual sessions.
